



- Important Dates in the History of the Company:**
- Founded as a fruit and vegetable shop in Portland, Maine, in 1883 by Arthur and Howard Hannaford
 - Incorporated in 1902
 - Sold Hannaford common stock for the first time in 1971, when net earnings reached \$1 million
 - Hannaford stock traded on the New York Stock Exchange in 1986 (NYSE-HRD)
 - 1987 was the first \$1 billion sales year
 - 1991 sales exceeded \$2 billion
 - 1997 sales exceeded \$3 billion
 - 2000 acquired by Delhaize America, Inc., Southeast division divested
 - 2001 DZA stock purchased by parent company-Delhaize Group of Brussels, Belgium
 - 2004 acquired Victory Super Markets, a Massachusetts-based chain with 19 stores
- People:**
- More than 26,000 full-time and part-time associates
 - 26 officers: Ronald C. Hodge, President and Chief Executive Officer
- Retail Stores:**
- 160 supermarkets in five states, including Maine, New Hampshire, Massachusetts, Vermont, and New York, operating under the name Hannaford Supermarket and Hannaford Supermarket and Pharmacy
 - Major market areas include Portland, Bangor, ME; Manchester, NH; Burlington, VT; Albany, Lower Hudson Valley, NY; North Central, MA
 - Store formats include combination stores with pharmacies and conventional supermarkets; average store size is 49,300 sq. ft.; current prototype stores range from 35,000-84,000 sq. ft.; 127 stores have in-store pharmacies; 146 stores have Nature's Place.
- Distribution System:**
- All retail stores and 30 wholesale customers (independent supermarkets) supplied by three company-owned and operated distribution centers and Hannaford Trucking Company
 - Two full-line grocery distribution centers are in South Portland, ME (520,192 sq. ft), Schodack, NY (489,000 sq. ft.). General merchandise, pharmaceuticals and specialty foods are supplied through a 200,000-sq.-ft. facility in Winthrop, ME
 - Hannaford Trucking Company, founded in 1982, is a wholly owned Hannaford subsidiary and a licensed irregular route common carrier
